**Amendment of List of Exempt Native Specimens**

I, CLAIRE HOWLETT, Acting Assistant Secretary, Marine Environment Branch, as Delegate of the Minister for the Environment and Water Resources pursuant to subsection 303DC(1) of the *Environment Protection and Biodiversity Conservation Act 1999* (EPBC Act), hereby amend the list of exempt native specimens established under section 303DB of the EPBC Act by including in the list the following specimens:

- Specimens that are or are derived from fish or invertebrates, other than specimens that belong to species listed under Part 13 of the EPBC Act, taken in the Western Australia Shark Bay Crab Interim Managed Fishery, as defined in the *Shark Bay Crab Fishery (Interim) Management Plan 2005*, made under the Western Australia *Fish Resources Management Act 1994* and *Fish Resources Management Regulations 1995*.

with a notation that inclusion of the specimens in the list is subject to the following restrictions or conditions:

- The specimen, or the fish or invertebrate from which it is derived, was taken lawfully.
- The specimens are covered by the declaration of an approved Wildlife Trade Operation under section 303FN of the EPBC Act in relation to the fishery.
