**Revocation of an Accreditation of a Plan, Regime or Policy for the Purposes of  
Part 13, Acts Interpretation Act 1901 section 33(3); Accreditation of a Plan,  
Regime or Policy for the Purposes of Part 13**

I, NIGEL ROUTH, Assistant Secretary, Marine Biodiversity Policy Branch, as Delegate of the Minister for the Environment, Heritage and the Arts pursuant to sections 208A, 222A, 245 and 265 of the *Environment Protection and Biodiversity Conservation Act 1999* (EPBC Act) and section 33(3) of the *Acts Interpretation Act 1901* revoke the accreditation dated 14 July 2006 for the Tasmanian Giant Crab Fishery.

Being satisfied that:

- The Tasmanian *Fisheries (Giant Crab) Rules 2006* for the Tasmanian Giant Crab Fishery, in force under the Tasmanian *Living Marine Resources Management Act 1995*, requires persons engaged in fishing under the Tasmanian *Fisheries (Giant Crab) Rules 2006* to take all reasonable steps to ensure that members of listed threatened species, listed migratory species, cetaceans and listed marine species are not killed or injured as a result of the fishing; and
- The fishery to which the management regime relates is not likely to adversely affect:
  - the survival or recovery in nature of any listed threatened species; or
  - the conservation status of a listed migratory species, cetacean, or listed marine species or a population of that species,

I hereby accredit the Tasmanian *Fisheries (Giant Crab) Rules 2006* for the Tasmanian Giant Crab Fishery, in force under the Tasmanian *Living Marine Resources Management Act 1995*, pursuant to sections 208A, 222A, 245 and 265 of the EPBC Act for the purposes of Divisions 1, 2, 3 and 4 respectively of Part 13 of the EPBC Act.
