**Instrument imposing conditions on accreditation of plans, regimes and policies –
South Australian Marine Scalefish Fishery, September 2019**

I, JOHN GIBBS, Assistant Secretary, Wildlife Trade, as Delegate of the Minister for the Environment, pursuant to subsection 303AA(5) of the *Environment Protection and Biodiversity Conservation Act 1999*, hereby vary the accreditation of the management regime for the South Australian Marine Scalefish Fishery (accredited pursuant to an instrument dated 18/12/2018) by varying the conditions to which the accreditation of the management regime for the South Australian Marine Scalefish Fishery is subject, by replacing the conditions with the following condition:

PIRSA to continue:

- a) maintaining management measures, directed toward reducing and managing the impact of fishing activity on Australian Sea Lions
- b) monitoring and reviewing, the adequacy of its Australian Sea Lion interaction mitigation management measures, in consultation with relevant stakeholders
- c) to include effort reports within the annual reports, outlining effort using large mesh nets, particularly in ‘high risk blocks’ of the fishery, where those records are not confidential under the *Fisheries Management Act 2007*.
