**Instrument imposing conditions on accreditation of plans, regimes and policies –
QUEENSLAND GULF OF CARPENTARIA INSHORE FIN FISH FISHERY,
MARCH 2019**

I, PAUL MURPHY, Assistant Secretary, Wildlife Trade and Biosecurity Branch, as Delegate of the Minister for the Environment, pursuant to subsection 303AA(5) of the *Environment Protection and Biodiversity Conservation Act 1999*, hereby vary the accreditation of the management regime for the Queensland Gulf of Carpentaria Inshore Fin Fish Fishery (accredited pursuant to an instrument dated 10 September 2014) by varying the conditions to which the accreditation of the management regime for the Queensland Gulf of Carpentaria Inshore Fin Fish Fishery is subject by replacing the conditions with the following conditions:

Condition 1:

The Queensland Department of Agriculture and Fisheries to work with stakeholders to determine an improved data collection and validation approach that can validate the number of interactions with all bycatch, which will include protected species.

Condition 2:

Queensland Department of Agriculture and Fisheries to implement mitigation measures to ensure interactions with protected species are kept to a minimum.
