**Revocation of Accreditation of a Plan, Regime or Policy for the purposes of Part 13  
Accreditation of a Plan, Regime or Policy for the purposes of Part 13**

I, TONY BURKE, Minister for Sustainability, Environment, Water, Population and Communities:

- (a) revoke, under section 33(3) of the *Acts Interpretation Act 1901*, the accreditation of the Macquarie Island Toothfish Fishery dated 23 March 2006; and
- (b) being satisfied that:
  - i) the *Macquarie Island Toothfish Fishery Management Plan 2006* in force under the *Fisheries Management Act 1991* requires persons engaged in fishing under the plan to take all reasonable steps to ensure that members of listed threatened species, listed migratory species, cetaceans and listed marine species are not killed or injured as a result of the fishing; and
  - ii) the fishery to which the plan relates does not, or is not likely to, adversely affect:
    - a) the survival or recovery in nature of any listed threatened species; or
    - b) the conservation status of a listed migratory species, cetacean, or listed marine species or a population of that species,

accredit the *Macquarie Island Toothfish Fishery Management Plan 2006* under sections 208A, 222A, 245 and 265 of the *Environment Protection and Biodiversity Conservation Act 1999* (EPBC Act) for the purposes of Divisions 1, 2, 3 and 4 respectively of Part 13 of the EPBC Act.
