

Under the *Administrative Appeals Tribunal Act 1975*, a person whose interests are affected by this decision may apply for a statement of reasons and for independent review of the decision. An application for a statement of reason may be made in writing to the Department of the Environment, Water, Heritage and the Arts within 28 days of the date of the declaration. An application for independent review may be made to the Administrative Appeals Tribunal on payment of the relevant fee within 28 days of the date of the declaration, or if reasons are sought, within 28 days of receipt of reasons. Further information may be obtained from the Director, Sustainable Fisheries Section.

Declaration of the Harvest Operations of the Western Australian South Coast Crustacean as an approved Wildlife Trade Operation, December 2008

ADDITIONAL PROVISIONS (section 303FT)

Relating to the harvesting of fish specimens that are, or are derived from, fish or invertebrates, other than specimens of species listed under Part 13 of the *Environment Protection and Biodiversity Conservation Act 1999*, taken in the Western Australian South Coast Crustacean Fishery (SCCF).

1. Operation of the fishery will be carried out in accordance with the SCCF management regime in force under the *Fish Resources Management Act 1994*.
2. The Department of Fisheries, Western Australia (DFWA) to advise the Department of the Environment, Water, Heritage and the Arts (DEWHA) of any intended change to the SCCF management arrangements that may affect the assessment of the fishery against the criteria on which EPBC Act decisions are based.
3. By 9 February 2009, DFWA to release the SCCF Discussion Paper containing the new proposed management arrangements for public consultation.
