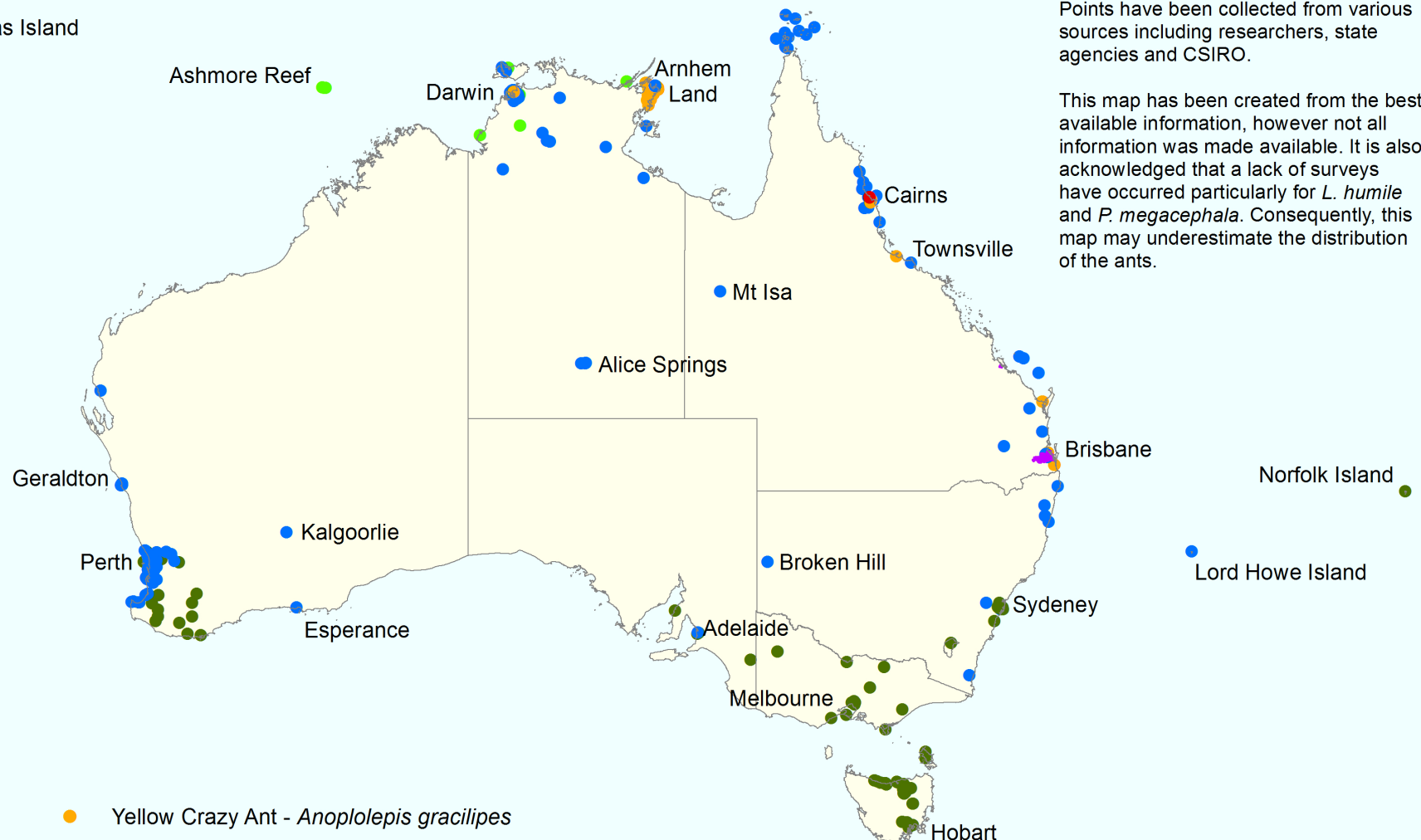


Tramp Ant Species

This map shows the distribution of tramp ant species identified in the Tramp Ant Threat Abatement Plan.

Points have been collected from various sources including researchers, state agencies and CSIRO.

This map has been created from the best available information, however not all information was made available. It is also acknowledged that a lack of surveys have occurred particularly for *L. humile* and *P. megacephala*. Consequently, this map may underestimate the distribution of the ants.



- Yellow Crazy Ant - *Anoplolepis gracilipes*
- Tropical Fire Ant - *Solenopsis geminata*
- Electric Ant - *Wasmannia auropunctata*
- Argentine Ant - *Linepithema humile*
- African Big-Headed Ant - *Pheidole megacephala*
- Red Imported Fire Ant - *Solenopsis invicta*
